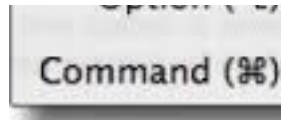


KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS

Whether you are using a MAC or a PC the shortcuts are the same. The key is to remember which command to use.

The **MAC** uses the **Command Feature**



The **PC** uses the **Control Feature**



Both instruments use the same keystrokes as shown below

MAC-KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS	PC-KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS
COMMAND-A= SELECT ALL	CTRL A= SELECT ALL
COMMAND-B= BOLD	CTRL-B= BOLD
COMMAND-C= COPY	CTRL C= COPY
COMMAND-D= SELECT FONT	CTRL D= SELECT FONT
COMMAND- D= SELECT FONT	CTRL D= SELECT FONT
COMMAND-N= NEW	CTRL N= NEW
COMMAND-O= OPEN	CTRL O= OPEN
COMMAND-P= PRINT	CTRL P= PRINT
COMMAND-Q= QUIT	CTRL Q= QUIT
COMMAND-S= SAVE	CTRL S= SAVE
COMMAND-T= TAB	CTRL T= TAB
COMMAND-U= UNDERLINE	CTRL U= UNDERLINE
COMMAND-V= PASTE	CTRL V= PASTE
COMMAND-X= CUT	CTRL X= CUT
COMMAND-Z= UNDO	CTRL Z= UNDO

Printing your screen on a MAC and PC is different too. The commands for that are as follows:

MAC-Printing Screen Directions	PC Printing Screen Directions
Command Shift #3 -Captures entire screen	Print Screen Button-Click
Command Shift #4 Only captures that image
